TRANSPORTATION

From Belgrade Airport

To travel from/to Belgrade airport and the city center:

By taxi: A counter for issuing certificates of fixed price (vouchers) for taxi transport is located in the international arrivals area

By bus:

- A1 Mini bus

Route: Airport – Slavija Square (Kralja Milutina Street) – Airport

Ticket price - RSD 400 (on the bus)

Approximate travel time - 30 minutes

- Public Transportation Line 72

Route: Airport-Zeleni venac Square

Ticket price - RSD89 (if purchased on the kiosk), RSD150 (if purchased on the bus)

Approximate travel time - 30–40 minutes

- Public Transportation Line 607

Route: Surčin – New Belgrade

Ticket price - RSD89 (if purchased on the kiosk), RSD150 (if purchased on the bus)
Approximate travel time - 30 minutes

- Public Transportation Line 860 I

Route: Sava square – Baric Industrial Zone

Ticket price – RSD 179 (if purchased on the kiosk), RSD 300 (if purchased on the bus)

Approximate travel time - 80 minutes

PASSPORTS AND VISAS

All visitors should be holding a valid passport or other forms of travel documents to enter and stay in Serbia.

Please note it is your **responsibility** to have a valid documentation to enter in Serbia
Please check your itinerary and note the airports that you will be transiting.

TRAVEL INSURANCE, HEALTH AND COVID-19 INFORMATION

Serbia disclaims all responsibility for medical, accident and travel insurance, for compensation for death or disability, for loss of or damage to personal property and for any other costs or losses that may be incurred during travel time or the period of participation. In this context, it is strongly recommended that you obtain international medical insurance for the entire period of participation, including travel time.

CURRENCY EXCHANGE

Hotels in Belgrade accept payments with debit and credit cards (Visa, Mastercard, American Express). It is nonetheless advisable to check directly with the hotel you will be staying in which types of credit cards are accepted. Credit and debit cards are generally accepted in Serbia. Some shops, restaurant and bars in the city centre might accept only cash, therefore it is advisable to have cash with you during your stay in Belgrade

There are banks and ATMs in the city centre that work with foreign cards. Withdrawing money from an ATM may result in surcharges. Some banks are also able to change main foreign currencies into local currency.

SECURITY INFORMATION

Participants are asked to take the normal precautions when travelling abroad. Keep your valuables in the hotel safe, and ensure that you do not carry your money, credit cards and travel documents in a conspicuous manner.
