

Following the European Commission request for engagement through the organization of consultations and MC mandate, IPA ADRION:

- Organized an online consultation in cooperation with other five Interreg transnational programmes
- Participated to a stakeholder consultation workshop in Sibenik in cooperation with Italy-Croatia CBC Programme and Eusair Facility Point (16 May 2024).

 Additional consultation workshop addressed to IPA ADRION 1st call granted projects (Bled, 23 October 2024)



Main aims:

- Engage interested persons of the IPA ADRION participating countries
- Collect relevant views on the current transnational cooperation concept
- Collect relevant views on the opportunities and challenges of Interreg projects
- Collect relevant views on the future of Interreg funds
- Identify, if present, valuable suggestions to be included in the harvesting report that IPA ADRION shall elaborate and send to the European Commission by the end of 2024



Methodological approach

- Participatory workshop
- Plenary (at the beginning and at the end of the workshop) and group sessions envisaged
- Asked questions will be the same asked in the online consultation
- Groups involved in different topics (i.e.: not the same questions will be addressed to all groups) to ensure the coverage of all the topics
- Each group shall be supported and coordinated by a facilitator (JS members and Interact representative). The facilitator shall:
 - Ask questions and stimulate discussion
 - Encourage the participation of all the group members
 - Report key ideas
 - Introduce and summarize the group discussion before/after every round
 - Remain neutral
 - Highlights 2-3 key takeaways to share during the closing plenary session



Methodological approach

- To ensure consistency with the already available information and data analysis , questions included in the online consultation will be asked.
- Half of the groups will answer questions 1-4 and question 9
- Half of the groups will answer questions 5-8 and question 10

List of questions

Questions included in the EC Guidelines and further elaborated in view of the online consultations are:

Question 1: What is the **key challenge in your area** that should be addressed through transnational cooperation?

Question 2: What are **key benefits that transnational cooperation offers** to stakeholders like you?

Question 3: Do you see any **shortcomings** in how your transnational cooperation efforts are currently supported? If yes, please explain.

Question 4: What are concrete **obstacles** that prevent stakeholders like you from cooperating transnationally with other partners?

Question 5: Are there **things that you would like to do** through transnational Interreg programmes but currently you cannot?

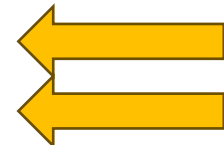
Question 6: What is the **most important novelty that you would like to see** in future Interreg transnational programmes?

Question 7: Should the **funding focus of transnational Interreg programmes** change? What would be your transnational dream project?

Question 8: Do you have any **additional ideas for facilitating cooperation** with your counterparts in other countries in the future?

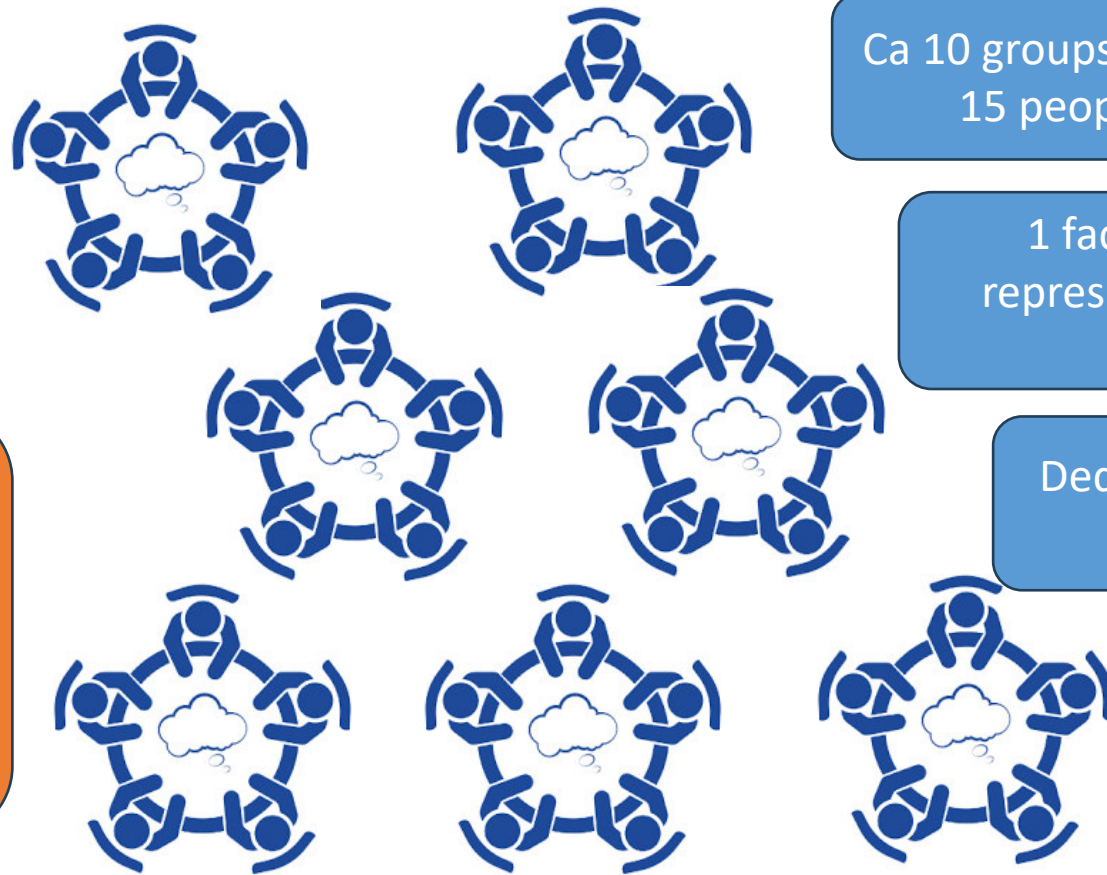
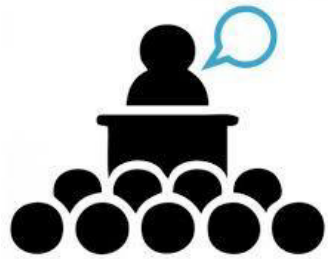
Question 9: In your opinion, what is the **added value of cooperating with Western Balkan partner countries** in the context of Interreg?

Methodological approach

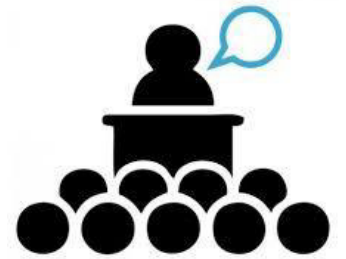


Ca 10 groups made of ca. 15 people each
