

THIRTEENTH IPA ADRION MONITORING COMMITTEE MEETING SUMMARY

The thirteenth IPA ADRION Monitoring Committee meeting took place on 18 and 19 March 2025 in Chania (Greece).

The Monitoring Committee was informed about the state of play of the programme implementation; in particular, the three strategic projects supporting the implementation of EUSAIR were invited to present their state of play. In relation to the above, it also approved a revision of the budget of the Cooperation Programme, by slightly increasing the budget of the Priority Axis 1, Specific Objective 1.1 (innovation) in view of the launch of the 2nd call for proposals and consequently reducing the amounts initially attributed to the Priority Axes 2 (environment) and 3 (non-urban transport).

The proposed application package of the second call for proposals was discussed and approved, as well as the date and location of the programme launch events to promote the call.

The Monitoring Committee also approved the report of the 2024 technical assistance reports (at programme and national level), as well as their provisional activities and related budget for the year 2025.

It also approved the decisions adopted by the first Evaluation Working Group meeting in charge of providing technical support to the Monitoring Committee regarding the independent evaluation of the IPA ADRION Programme.
