

Technical proposal on application package revision



- **Call duration:** Further postpone the call deadline (up to end of March 2026) to allow the projects to submit their proposals according to the last MC decision
- **Type of master to be implemented:** it can be changed on condition that its content, goals and duration remain unchanged.
- **Which institution accredits/recognizes:** any partner can ask for master accreditation/recognition.
- **Master based on existing framework:** (e.g.: title already present in the university masters' catalogue): the LP must provide evidence that double funding is excluded.
- **Accreditation independent evaluation:** the assessment is shifted as last step of the quality assessment (currently it is the first one). Intermediate submission of related documentation (i.e.: after the submission of the project proposal is accepted). It also includes the acceptance of the renewal of accreditation conditions if the available/submitted ones are close to be expired. The final documentation on accreditation/recognition can be submitted before the approval of the project by the MC.
- **Who does what within the partnership:** change of roles and tasks within the set partnership regarding the accreditation process are accepted upon condition that the final project goal as defined in the 2024-2020 granted projects is achieved (no specific requirements in this respect are however present in the application package).
- **Approval of the changes:** The revision of the application package shall enter into force retroactively. The text approved by the MC shall replace the application package as from December 2024
- **If what above is accepted:** Slightly revision the EoI & application manual is necessary
